

Passport to Summer Rules & Conditions

1. Must be 18 years of age or older to enter. There is no cost to enter. Void where prohibited by law.
2. The Cape Cod Museum Trail invites residents, visitors and alike (herein referred to as Photographers) from all levels of expertise to enter our [Passport to Summer](#) contest. All photos may be used in various Cape Cod Museum Trail communications and marketing (i.e. website, social media sites, press release, lobby displays, etc.).
3. Photographers need to find three (3) different Cape Cod Museums to complete the [Passport to Summer](#) contest. The Summer to Passport contest gives you ideas of museums to match the themes. A full list of museums can be located on the [Cape Cod Museum Trail](#) webpage.
4. Photos can be taken inside or outside the museum. There must be people in the photograph.
5. There will be one photo contest entry accepted per person. This will include photos in three (3) categories, one photo for each category of your choice. However, you must send your entry in one email, with all photo entries submitted together.
6. Photos that have been previously published, accepted for publication, or are under consideration by other publications are not eligible. By entering, each entrant agrees to release the Cape Cod Museum Trail, it's officers, directors, employees, agents, members, affiliates, suppliers, and distributors from all liability, claims, or actions of any kind whatsoever for injuries, damages, or losses, to persons and property which may be sustained in connection with the receipt, ownership, or in connection with the contest, including without limitation any third party claim for copyright infringement or a violation of an individual's right to privacy or publicity right
7. **How to Enter:**
 - A. Photo Submission – August 1, 2021 (12:00am) to September 6, 2021 (11:59pm)
 - B. The information we need in your email for your entry to be eligible:
 - * Your first and last name.
 - * Where you're from (your hometown or country if you're not from the U.S.)
 - * Where you were when you took the photo (include the name of the museum)
 - * Category of each photo from the [Passport to Summer](#) card.
 - * The date you took the photo.
 - C. Attach your photos! Remember to attach your photos to the email using the paper clip symbol at the top of the email toolbar. Note: Your photos should be submitted as high-resolution (300 dpi) image suitable for print and web use.

D. The entry deadline is Monday, September 6, 2021 by 11:59PM. No entries will be accepted after that time.

E. Entries can be sent to info@capecodmuseumtrail.com.

8. Winner will be randomly selected from all photo entries submitted during campaign period. One winner will be selected on September 7, 2021 and notified via email/phone.

If the selected winner cannot be contacted, is ineligible, fails to claim the prize within 15 days from the time award notification was sent, or fails to timely return a completed and executed declaration and releases as required, prize may be forfeited and an alternate winner selected. Winner will receive a gift basket valued at \$100.
